Creative Coders (For Middle Schooler)

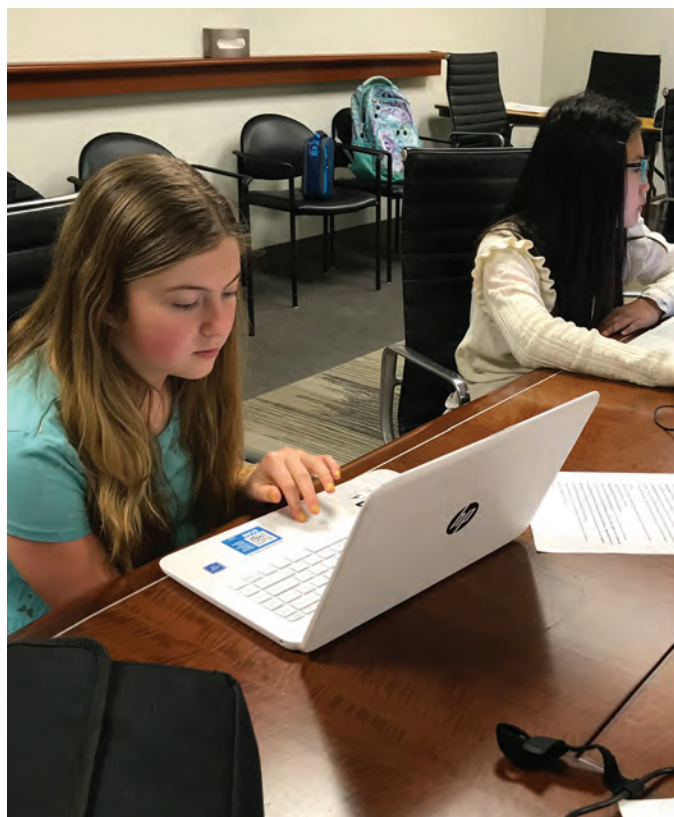
